

# A1203-ADA-CF3 Flash Card Reader

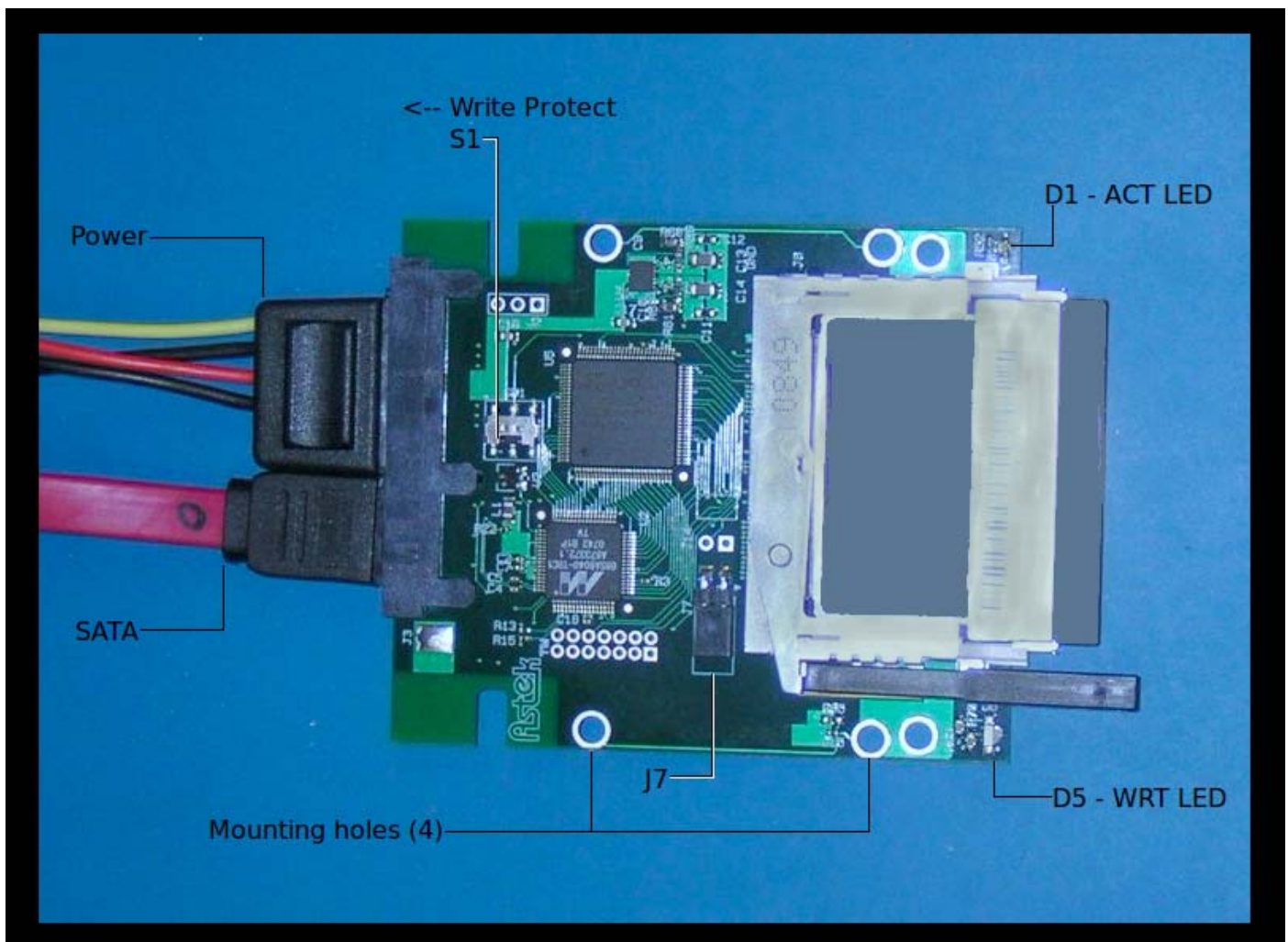
## Users Guide



### USING THE FLASH CARD READER

- Step 1. Ground yourself to prevent ESD damage.
- Step 2. Unpack the Reader and check for damage.
- Step 3. If desired, mount the Reader using the four mounting holes and appropriate screws.
- Step 4. Install J7 **AND** slide S1 away from the SATA cable to Write to the Flash Card.

- Step 5. Remove J7 **OR** slide S1 toward the SATA cable for Read Only operation.
- Step 6. Connect the Power and SATA cables.
- Step 7. Insert the CompactFlash™ card.
- Step 8. To verify operation, observe D1 and D5.  
D1 flashes during Read / Write operation.  
D5 is Red to indicate Read Only operation.  
D5 is Green to indicate Write Enable.
